I noted about 32 species of things (plants, insects, a bird, a spider) while hiking with Justice Miller.

Here are ten species we encountered, with a link to a photo/and or description of each.

**Encelia Farinosa - Brittlebush** (lots of yellow flowered bushes) Brittlebush

**Chaenactic - Pincushion flower** (Lots of white flowered small bushes. I think it is this species, fremontii, there are many species.)

**Lupinus Arizonicus - Arizona Lupine** (many once we were up a bit) <u>Arizona Lupine</u>

**Phacelia Crenulata - Notch-Leaf Scorpion-Weed** (my favorite common name, lots of purple flower stands)

**Vanessa cardui - Painted Lady** (butterflies flying by) Painted Lady

**Rafinesquia neomexicana - Desert Chicory** (one common name, my favorite flower find) <u>Desert Chicory</u>

**Cryptantha angustifolia - Narrow leaved cryptantha** (all over, small fuzzy bushes of white and green)
Narrow leaved cryptantha

**Ferocactus cylindraceus - California Barrel Cactus** (just a few) California Barrel Cactus

**Eleodes - Desert Stink Beetle** (just one) Desert Stink Beetle

**Geococcyx californianus - Greater Roadrunner** (just one) Greater Roadrunner
